LIGHTING HISTORY

Founded in 1762, Hadeland Glassverk is one of Norway's oldest industrial companies, maintaining continuous production from the earliest kerosene lamp through to the design led collections of today. The crystal luminaires are created in an array of jewel-like colours and exquisite patterns that are synonymous with the artisan production at Hadeland. It is inspiring to reflect on the passage of time and the period of trading that has established the company as one of the world's leading lights in artisan glass. With projects specified around the world, it is testament to the craftmanship and talent of the team in Norway.

As a mark of the strength of our archive, we revisited 8 of the early designs from Jonas Hidle and Arnulf

Bjorshol which were produced between 1930 and 1960. The models, which have a distinct mid-century handwriting and clear Norwegian aesthetic, now sit within the centre of our portfolio, perfectly describing the scope within Hadeland designs. Today Hadeland Glassverk is as busy with bespoke projects as it is with the production of the main portfolio of lights. The flexibility to design and manufacture to order, working alongside, architects, interior designers and clients, utilizing the full skill set of the team of artisans who hand craft these most precious objects, means the glassworks is buoyant and the design team continue to add to the core collections, pushing innovation and challenging the magnificent material that forms Hadelands renowned crystal glass.

DEN NORSKE OPERA

The 50sqm and 8,5 ton chandelier at the Oslo Opera House was designed in the collaboration with renowned Snøhetta Architects and Senior Desinger at Hadeland Glassverk Maud Bugge.

The chandelier is the center piece of the interior and consist of 5800 individual crystal elements, all mouth-blown and diamond-cutted using the same techniques as 260 years ago.



THE KENNEDY CENTRE, WASHINGTON DC A large and prestigious project for Hadeland Glassverk, 45 chandeliers and 42 lamps were delivered to The Kennedy Center in Washington DC in 1965. The exquisite chandeliers were designed by Jonas Hidle and manufactured at Hadeland Glassverk.







KAFFEBRENNERIET COFFEE SHOP, OSLO

The team at Hadeland searched the archives for a shape that would be sympathetic to this existing space while adding a new dimension. These beautiful archive lamps with their white glass, diffuse the light in a natural way, creating soft, ambient lighting for this commercial environment.

KRISTIANIA UNIVERSITY COLLEGE, OSLO

Both decorative and functional in terms if light output, this beautiful combination using the Crystal Ball's in different sizes, colours and patterns creates a warming atmosphere. All 96 pieces are mouth blown in our factory.

When AVA Eiendom embarked on a complete refurbishment of Karl Johans Street 14, for the H&M flagship store in Oslo, both client and tenant wanted a specifically designed light installation in the atrium that would extend 26M in height.

The Gravity project shows the result of great collaboration between lighting designer, Norwegian glass-blowing tradition and an ambitious client driven by quality. The chandelier extends over 7 floors and consists of 201 mouthblown, hand-ground crystal balls suspended in the atrium.

HURDAL TOWN HALL

For Hurdal Town Hall, Hadeland Glassverks senior designer, Maud Gjeruldsen Bugge, created a chandelier formed from 600 solid crystal cones. A perfect fit, as the municipality of Hurdal has a pinecone in its coat of arms. An iron custom canopy which has been aged and rusted, suspends a further 10 rings that hold the crystal cones descending across 5 sizes. The cones reflect the light perfectly, creating an evenly lit cone.

As part of the decoration, Maud Gjeruldsen Bugge, who is also an artist, completed a large painting and designed an art disc with frames matching the rough material used in the chandelier. Together, the chandelier and art combine in a hall where the municipality can hold intimate concerts and ceremonies-








VIA VIKA, OSLO

As a "2022 Norwegian Lighting Awards" winner, this custom made design made of brass and crystal glass has been a success. The chandeliers were specially made for the Via Vika project in Oslo and done in different sizes adapting to the height of the ceiling.








VÅLER CHURCH

Våler's traditional wooden church sadly burned down in 2009 and the discussion regarding the new church and its design immediately started. The magnificent new structure is one of Europe's largest wooden churches, attracting 4 architectural and design awards since its reopening in 2015. Hadeland Glassverk delivered 24 large glass pendants, each measuring 1 meter in height. They are mouthblown and diamond-cutted at Hadeland Glassverk.




CRYSTAL SPHERES

Each Crystal Sphere is mouth blown using the

same techniques utilized over 260 years ago. The pattern deployed in the cut glass is completely freehand and requires a skill that we are fortunate to have within the artisans at the glassworks. With the ability to be both contemporary and traditional, the Crystal Spheres are a perfect example of the craft of Hadeland.

OPTIC PATTERN

The Crystal Spheres incorporating an optic pattern cast a particularly beautiful light. To create the optic pattern the glass blower pushes the glass mass into a ring with standing slats, creating deep notches in the glass. Subsequently he blows the glass mass down into a smooth graphite mould, which gives the glass sphere an unpatterned outer core and a wavy inner core resulting in a mesmerising sphere.





SODA PATTERN

The uniqueness of the Soda pattern is that you will never find two identical Soda crystal spheres. The glass blowers create the bubble effect by sprinkling mineral powder (soda) on to a blown glass sphere and heating it back up before blowing it into shape. During the re-heating process the bubbles appear and is a process we have been using for many decades to create a quite alluring glass.



FROM THE 1930s-1960s ARE RE-LAUNCHED

From the 1930s to the 1960s, Hadeland Glassverk was one of Norway's largest suppliers of lighting, with deliveries to many public and private buildings in Norway and abroad. The archive lights were designed by the design team, at the time consisting of Jonas Hidle and Arnulf Bjørshol. Hidle was head of the drawing office at Christiania Glasmagasin and Bjørshol was the designer for Christiania Glasmagasin's Høvik Lighting department.

Spring 2019, the archive lamps were re-launched. The lighting moulds are made of wood, hand made by Hadeland Glassverk's own mould maker. To prevent the wooden moulds from burning up during the glass blowing process, they are immersed in water for several weeks prior to use, and are wet between each use. 4 glassblowers work on each item, before leaving it for cooling for between 4 hours to several days. After cooling, each item is prepared for grinding. The grinders do a rough grind, followed by a fine grind and then polish the edges carefully, according to the designers' sketches. Today's design team has tended to these precious classics by emphasizing and modernizing small details, and adding new and colours and fixtures. A total of 7 archive lights have been re-launched, several of them available in different sizes, as well as different globe and fixture colours.



The popular Archive light 4014 was designed in 1956, and is available in four sizes, the largest of which is 500 mm diameter - watching the glass blowers blow this magnificent light is a spectacular experience! The entire production of the archive lights takes place at Hadeland Glassverk. The wooden moulds are made by our own mould maker. The

lights are mouth blown deploying the same techniques we have been using for over 260 years ago. The cooling down process takes everything from 4 hours to several days, depending on the thickness of the glass. Finally, the lights get a rough grind, a fine grind and lastly, they are polished.
